Knowledge is Power 2 Peter 1:1-4 What are we to know? Or who? <u>Knowledge</u>- full discernment <u>Know</u>- be aware, see, understand <u>Beware</u>- be on guard, not be afraid. To avoid, obey to preserve <u>Remembrance</u>- bring to mind Philippians 3:7-10

Knowledge of the Bible does not equal spiritual maturity. Calling ourselves Christian does not deem it so. Knowing Jesus means living personally and purposefully through repentance, forgiveness and dependence on Him. This is real knowledge.
